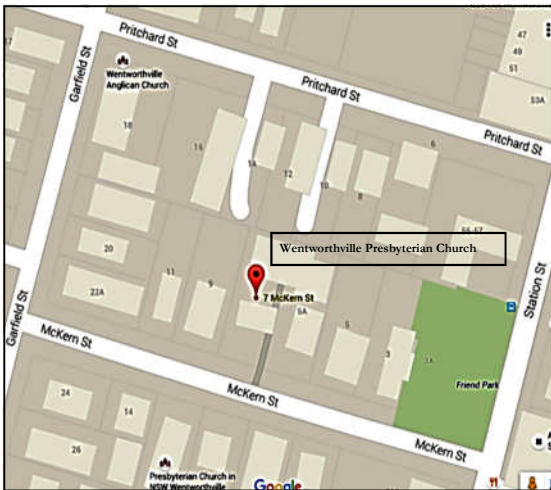

## Big Day Out—Being a Christian in a Changing World

### Our speaker:

Ian is married to Jenni. They have four adult children and two grandchildren. Ian is the principal of Christ College, where he also teaches Greek and New Testament. He has also been the minister of a church (Griffith Presbyterian) and a high school teacher in Tamworth and in Penrith. ### This year's topic:

Our society is rapidly changing as it pursues a utopian ideal, where all are equal to do what they want. But Christians have a different view of equality that is more to do with who you are than what you do. In a world that seeks individual rights above all, Christians put limits upon such rights. An unborn baby has rights, and the elderly should not seek a good death at the time of their choice.

Christianity is getting in the way. It needs to be suppressed. This situation is not new. It is as old as the book of Daniel, and there is much we can learn from this book.
